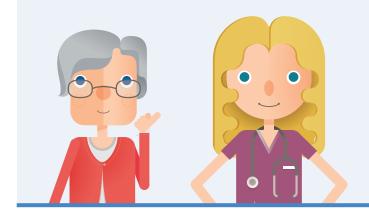


Patient-oriented discharge summary (PODS).

# PODS was created by caregivers and patients like you.



#### WHAT TO EXPECT

Your health care provider will give you a PODS and go through it with you. You will be told about your medications, upcoming appointments, how you can expect to feel, danger signals and what to do, and any lifestyle changes you need to make. You will also be given pointers to useful information and contact information with phone numbers.

IF THERE IS ANYTHING YOU DON'T UNDERSTAND OR IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR FOLLOW UP CARE, ASK Common phrases Your doctor may not realize he is talking in another language, for example, some common translations are:

COMMON INSTRUCTION

PLAIN LANGUAGE TRANSLATION

Take this medication 4 times a day

Take this pill with breakfast, lunch, and dinner, and at bedtime

Go see your primary caregiver within the next seven days You need to have an appointment with a doctor who knows you by next Monday
